

Instructions



Installation Instructions

- Site condition SpeedFloor™ by allowing it to come to room temperature (72°F) for a period of 24 hours prior to installation.
- 2. An expansion gap of 1/4" (6mm) is required around walls and other obstacles such as beams, cabinets and other equipment. Tiles should be laid around heavy equipment and not under them to allow for expansion and contraction.
- SpeedFloor™ can be cut to size or shape by using a saw. For best cutting results, use fine tooth saw blades designed to cut polymers.
- SpeedFloor™ tiles attach with a loop & hook system. The loops of one tile snap into the hooks of another tile.:



- 5. IMPORTANT—Start laying tile at the bottom left hand corner of the space to be covered.
- Set the first SpeedFloor™ tile (marked #1 below) paying special attention to which direction the loops of the tile are facing.
- Add the second SpeedFloor™ tile (marked #2 below) to its right, so that its loops are facing the same way as tile #1. If you are planning to use border tiles, attach them along the way.
- 8. Keep adding SpeedFloor™ tiles to the first row in this manner making sure that the loops of the tiles are always facing the same way.
- 9. When the first row is complete, start the second row always keeping the loops facing the same way, and so on and so on.
- 10. Suggestion: SpeedFloor™ tiles install easiest when you align the loops and hooks first and then apply pressure from your hand or the heel of your foot to make them snap together!
